A very famous theologian once said, "To err is human but to forgive is divine." Forgiveness is not easy for any of us, but we just have to try. If we do it as often as we can, we get used to it. Forgiveness isn't easy. In fact, it is impossible without grace.

Forgiveness is a great idea until you actually need to forgive. Then the thought of offering them unconditional and complete forgiveness, doesn't come easily or naturally. Resentment is a bitter pill yet easier to swallow. We all need to prepare the way for the Lord. How do we forgive?

Firstly, we need to put everything in prayer. "Lord; I can't possibly forgive that person". The next step, "Lord, forgive me, heal my anger and resentment so that I may forgive from the heart and be set free". We forgive more readily when we know we are forgiven.
