I was reminded of her for our coffee morning on female and male roles. She wrote All Desires Known when she wrote a complete series of alternative collects for the lectionary year and other prayers.

On the back it says "All Desires Known is a distinctive collection of usable, lucid and evocative new prayers in which personal and political longing inform one another in the presence of God, and a feminist perspective is integrated with a thoroughly biblical tradition of Christian worship."

Lent 4 Mothering Sunday
